

## Fig Lang in *The Giver* ([Kahoot! Review](#))

<b>Example from the Text</b> <b>HIGHLIGHT the fig lang you as you find it!</b>	<b>Type of Fig Lang?</b> <u>Choices:</u> simile, metaphor, alliteration, hyperbole, personification	<b>How do you know?</b>
<p>"Squinting toward the sky, he had seen the sleek jet, almost a blur at its high speed, go past, and a second later heard the blast of sound that followed" (1).</p>		
<p>"Lily considered, and shook her head. 'I don't know. They acted like...like...' 'Animals?' Jonas suggested... 'That's right,' Lilly said...'Like animals" (7).</p>		
<p>"Now, seeing the newchild and its expression, he was reminded that the light eyes were not only a rarity but gave the one who had them a certain look...as if one were looking into the clear water of the river, down to the bottom, where things might lurk which hadn't been discovered yet" (27).</p>		
<p>"He sank back down into his chair, puzzled" (46). <b>He was puzzled.</b></p>		
<p>"He couldn't bear to see their faces darkened with shame" (73).`</p>		
<p>"He felt fear flutter within him" (78).</p>		
<p>"His heart swelled with gratitude and pride" (81).</p>		
<p><i>Jonas just told his parents he was starving.</i></p>		

<p>"He was not starving, it was pointed out. He was hungry" (89).</p>		
<p><i>Speaking about reliving the memories, the Giver says this:</i></p> <p>"It's like going downhill through deep snow on a sled" (99).</p>		
<p>"He saw his own hands, furred again with snow, holding the rope" (118).</p>		
<p><i>Jonas has just crashed on the sled.</i></p> <p>"Then, the first wave of pain...It was as if a hatchet lay lodged in his leg, slicing through each nerve with a hot blade. In his agony he perceived the word 'fire' and felt flames licking at the torn bone and flesh" (137).</p>	<p><b>NOTE:</b> There are two examples in this passage.</p>	
<p>"Jonas watched as his father bent over the squirming new child on the bed. 'And you, little guy, you're only five pounds ten ounces. A shrimp'" (185).</p>		
<p>"Jonas felt a ripping sensation inside himself, the feeling of terrible pain clawing its way forward to emerge in a cry" (189).</p>		
<p><i>Jonas is trying to warm himself and Gabe with a memory when they are very tired and cold at the end of the book.</i></p> <p>"Then it flickered suddenly, and he felt tiny tongues of heat begin to creep across and into</p>		

his frozen feet and legs" (221).
